

## ORDINANCE NO. #1 -2015

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 230 SOLID WASTE, ARTICLE II, RECYCLING, SECTION 230-3, DEFINITIONS, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF EGG HARBOR AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ADOPTED, THE PROVISIONS OF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 230 Solid Waste, Article II, Recycling, Section 230-3, Definitions, Designated Recyclable Materials is hereby amended to include the following:

- K. Asphalt and Concrete –Asphalt, Brick, Block and Concrete from the commercial sector. To be delivered to an approved NJDEP Class B Recycling Center.
- P. Propane tanks (empty twenty-pound size or less) may be delivered to ACUA or private sector recycling or re-use facility.
- Q. Tires
- R. Auto & Truck Bodies - from both residential and commercial sectors
- S. CFC Refrigerants- from both residential and commercial sectors.
- T. Ferrous Scrap metal - from both residential and commercial sectors
- U. Fluorescent Bulbs- from the commercial sector
- V. Oil Contaminated Soils- from both residential and commercial sectors
- W. Oil filters - from the commercial sector
- X. Textiles - from both residential and commercial sectors


SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.


SECTION 3: Should any sentence, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage, publication and adoption in the manner prescribed by law.
