Location: Egg Harbor City Municipal Building, located at 500 London Avenue in Egg Harbor City, NJ 08215

The City of Egg Harbor is performing preliminary engineering to construct 5-foot wide bike lanes in both directions along 2 miles of Philadelphia Avenue (CR 563), from Diesterweg Street to Egg Harbor City Lake and Campground. The bikeway will also serve as access to the Cedar Creek High School and the Egg Harbor City Lake and Campground. Construction of the new bike lanes will require placement of new signage and striping, stormwater swales, and minor roadway widening along Philadelphia Avenue (CR 563), as well as new concrete parapets and guiderail for Atlantic County Bridge ECH-13 over Landing Creek. The project team has performed data collection, environmental and cultural resource investigations, and advanced layout and design for the proposed pedestrian connection, which will be presented at the meeting. The Public Information Meeting will be followed by a presentation to the City Council at 7 pm. The project is Federally Funded through the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) - Transportation Alternatives Program, from a grant received by the City for future construction. The City is extending an invitation to the general public to attend a Public Information Meeting to procure input and feedback regarding this project.
