Proclamation

Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day

October 6, 2020

WHEREAS, New Jersey is in the midst of a life-threatening opioid abuse epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the Partnership for a Drug-Free New Jersey has designated October 6, 2020 as Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day – an initiative with a dual purpose: to educate families of the addictive qualities of opioid pain medicines and their link to heroin abuse rates in New Jersey, and communicate to physicians information on safer prescribing messages found in the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines for prescribing opiates, which include considering other therapies, setting realistic treatment goals with patients and discussing with patients the pros and cons of opioids; and

WHEREAS, the State Senate and General Assembly jointly resolved that October 6 shall be permanently designated as “Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day” in New Jersey in order to raise awareness about the dangers of, and the link between, opioid abuse and heroin addiction and to educate health care providers, community leaders, State lawmakers and members of the public about the opioid abuse epidemic and its effects throughout the State of New Jersey and across the country; and

WHEREAS, Join Together Atlantic County (JTAC) supports initiatives designed to raise awareness about opiate abuse in New Jersey and take steps to prevent addiction

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of Egg Harbor City that October 6, 2020 be recognized as Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day in Egg Harbor City, New Jersey.

ORDINANCE #17-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF BARGAINING PERSONNEL OF EGG HARBOR CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:9-165, the setting of such salaries shall be by promulgation of City Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of Egg Harbor City, Atlantic County, State of New Jersey as follows;

SECTION 1. SALARIES, that the salaries and compensation of Bargaining and Non-Bargaining personnel of Egg Harbor City hereinafter named shall be fixed and determined to be the salary range as follows:
